



Subject: Term 4 Remote Learning Resource Pick up

Dear Parents,

I hope that you and your family have been enjoying these spring holidays and having a break from school and devices.

We begin this term with remote learning on Tuesday 5 October but are all looking forward to welcoming the children back to face-to-face learning very soon, in line with the announced return dates - Prep, Kindergarten and Year 1 on Monday 25 October, Year 2 and Year 6 on Monday 1 November, and Years 3 to 5 on Monday 8 November.

We will be communicating with you in Week 2 (week beginning Monday 11 October) about how we will provide a safe return to school. We will be implementing measures such as ensuring our classrooms are well ventilated, teachers will wear masks inside and outside, masks will be optional for Junior School children, children learning and playing within their own cohort and COVID safe drop off and pick up. I will communicate the measures in much more detail in Week 2 and provide an opportunity for parents to ask questions or raise any concerns.

We encourage all families to persevere until their cohort return date. We have made some improvements and minor changes to the delivery of our remote learning which includes more Zoom teaching times for Years 3-6 classes, writing support for some Year 3-6 students, extension classes for Years 5 and 6 and an awards assembly posted on Friday. We will continue to provide supervision for students who need to come to school.

To help remote learning be even more successful, teachers from Prep, Kindergarten and all years from Years 1 to 5 have produced learning at home packs. These packs will support remote learning, provide students with meaningful worksheets and help students transition back to school. We will be distributing them at a **COVID Safe Resource Pick up next Tuesday 5 October from 1pm – 3:30 pm.**

We will also be distributing home reader packs to children in Kindergarten, Year 1 and Year 2. This will provide some reading material for your child for the coming weeks but cannot be exchanged until your child returns to school.

At the pick up we will also collect any library books or home readers that you have at home. Please check your home for any books or novels to return. You can pass them to us through the car window at the collection point on Tuesday.

To help us distribute these resources we would appreciate those with surnames A-K coming between 1 pm – 2 pm and L-Z between 2 pm – 3 pm, with the kiosk remaining open until 3:30 pm. Please display your child's surname and class clearly on the



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windscreen. It would be best for parents to come at this time, but if you are unable, resources will be available to collect from the Breezeway on Wednesday.

Thank you for your ongoing support of your child and our school as we continue with remote learning and then transition back to onsite learning. Join with us by praying for our students, our families, our school and nation during this time.
