Junior School Uniform Requirements

School uniforms give students a sense of belonging to the school and create an identity for the school in the community. Therefore, the school expects students to follow the requirements below. Teachers have the discretion to interpret and apply these guidelines. A member of the school executive is the final authority if a value judgement needs to be made on a students' overall appearance. Students who do not follow these guidelines, or whose overall appearance is unsatisfactory, may receive a disciplinary consequence.

The requirements refer to school garments e.g. navy school shorts. Any garment referred to as a 'school' garment can only be purchased at the Shire Christian School uniform shop.

General Expectations

- ▶ Summer uniform is worn during Terms 1 and 4.
- ▶ Winter uniform is worn during Terms 2 and 3.
- ▶ All uniforms must fit properly and be in a good condition.
- ▶ Boys who wear a school jumper over the summer uniform must tuck their shirt in.
- ▶ School jumpers or vests are not to be worn with the sport uniform. However, in the event of exceptionally cold weather, the school vest or jumper may be worn under the school sport jacket, but not as a replacement for the sport jacket.
- ▶ Girls: hair longer than shoulder length must be worn fully tied back.
- ▶ Boys: hair must be groomed, neat and tidy, well above the collar and out of their eyes. Hair must not be of a length that can be tied back.
- ▶ Only a natural hair colour is permitted.

Makeup & Jewellery

- ▶ Makeup is not part of the K-6 school uniform.
- ▶ Students are welcome to wear a watch.
- ▶ Girls are allowed one single sleeper or plain stud earring in each earlobe.
- ▶ No necklaces, rings or bracelets are allowed.

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Additional Items	
Bags	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▶ School backpack or trolley bag used according to manufacturer's instructions.▶ School library bag as sold in the uniform shop▶ School excursion / shoe bag as sold in the uniform shop (optional)
Hats	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▶ School navy, brimmed hat or baseball hat to be worn at school in the playground, on excursions and at sport.
Sunglasses (Optional)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▶ UV protective lens, modest frames, preferably in a single darker colour
Shoes	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▶ Black leather lace-up school shoes with firm sole and distinct low heel.▶ P-2 students may wear shoes with Velcro or buckle style closures.▶ Sport shoes: runner/jogger-style shoes with supportive structure (providing ankle support) to be worn with sport uniform.▶ P-2 may wear joggers with Velcro style closures.
Hair	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▶ K-6 Girls: Red ribbons, scrunchies. Hair elastics: matching natural hair colour.



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Secondary Uniform Requirements

School uniforms give students a sense of belonging to the school and create an identity for the school in the community. Therefore, the school expects students to follow the requirements below. Teachers have the discretion to interpret and apply these guidelines. A member of the school executive is the final authority if a value judgement needs to be made on a students' overall appearance. Students who do not follow these guidelines, or whose overall appearance is unsatisfactory, may receive a disciplinary consequence.

The requirements refer to school garments e.g. navy school shorts. Any garment referred to as a 'school' garment can only be purchased at the Shire Christian School uniform shop.

General Expectations

- ▶ Summer uniform is worn during Terms 1 and 4.
- ▶ Winter uniform is worn during Terms 2 and 3.
- ▶ The blazer is the compulsory outer garment for warmth.
- ▶ The Secondary school sports jacket is the outer garment with the sport uniform and should only be worn with this uniform.
- ▶ All uniforms must fit properly and be in a good condition.

1. Makeup

- ▶ Years 7-10: no makeup.
- ▶ Years 11- 12: girls are permitted to wear a light covering of natural appearance foundation. No other makeup permitted. Natural nails only.

2. Jewellery

- ▶ Girls are allowed one single sleeper or a small plain stud earring in each earlobe.
- ▶ Students are welcome to wear a watch.
- ▶ No necklaces or bracelets are allowed.
- ▶ Girls in Year 11-12 may wear one plain, flat ring.
- ▶ Apart from a single piercing in the lobe of each ear (girls only), no body piercings of any kind are allowed, nor are clear spacers or coverings to hide body piercings.

3. Hair

- ▶ Girls: only a natural colour is permitted. Hair longer than shoulder length must be worn fully tied back. Navy ribbons and scrunchies. Hair elastics matching natural hair colour.
- ▶ Boys: hair must be groomed, neat and tidy, well above the collar and out of their eyes. Hair must not be of a length that can be tied back. Faces must be clean-shaven. Hair must be a natural colour.

Outer Garments

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| 7-12 | <ul style="list-style-type: none">▶ Terms 1 and 4 - the boy's summer school shirt/the girl's summer school blouse or the blazer are the only 2 outer garments allowed when travelling to and from school and at all school assemblies.▶ Terms 2 and 3 - the blazer is the required outer garment when travelling to and from school and at all school assemblies▶ School vests and jumpers may be worn as the outer garment during the school day, although not when travelling to and from school or at school assemblies.▶ Navy fine knit scarf |
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Additional Items: Years 7 to 12

Bags	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▶ School backpack or trolley bag used according to manufacturer's instructions▶ School excursion / shoe bag as sold in the uniform shop (optional)▶ NB: No other bags are allowed without prior permission
Hats	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▶ School baseball caps may be required for some excursions and sporting events. Students are encouraged to wear them in the playground.
Sunglasses (Optional)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▶ UV protective lens, modest frames, in a single darker colour.
Shoes	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▶ Black leather lace-up school shoes with firm sole and distinct low heel. The leather should be firm to provide protection when worn in specialist areas such as TAS, Science and Visual Arts classrooms.▶ Runner/jogger-style shoes with supportive structure (providing ankle support) to be worn with the sport uniform.
Under garments	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▶ Students are permitted to wear light coloured, plain singlets or T shirts underneath their school shirt or blouse on the understanding that the under garment is not visible.
